

TIPS FOR A COMPETITIVE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This document provides helpful tips in completing The San Diego Foundation's Common Scholarship Application. Tips are organized into sections correlating to sections in the application.

Contact Information

Check that your email and phone number are correct

Finances

- If tax forms are not available, estimate income
- If applicable, provide detailed information on your financial situation
- Avoid leaving blank spaces, if possible

Extracurricular Activities & Work Experience

- Provide accurate timeline for activities and work experience
- Explain the focus of the organization/club if it isn't clear
- Include ALL activities from the past 4 years
- Avoid putting the same activities or work experience in multiple places

Personal Statements

- Do not rush
- Give yourself time to develop your response
- Be clear and informative
- Ensure the response is about your experience
- Differentiate yourself by showing your passion
- Avoid going off topic
- Proof and review your first draft
- Have a knowledgeable person proof and review your response

Letter of Recommendation (if applicable)

- Choose a respected reference/recommender
- This person should know you well
- This person should be able to write a *good* recommendation
- Ask the individual before providing their information
- Make sure the letter is submitted by the deadline
