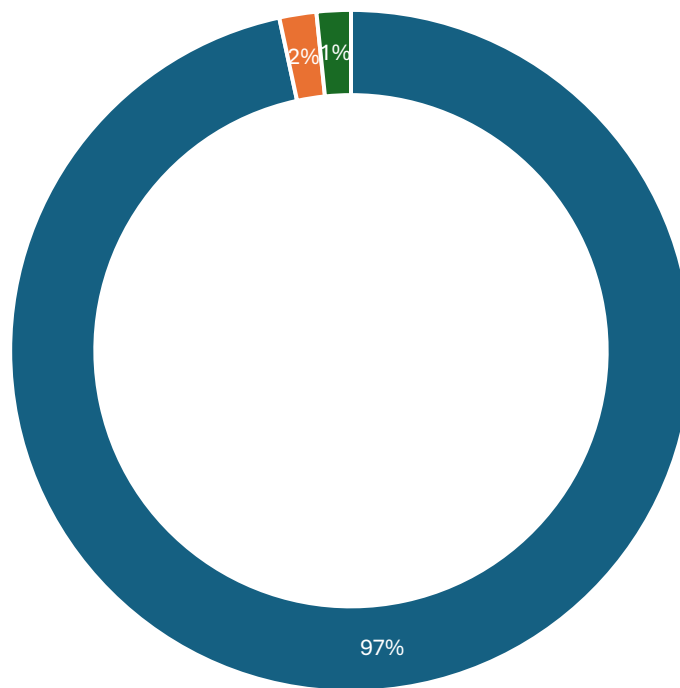

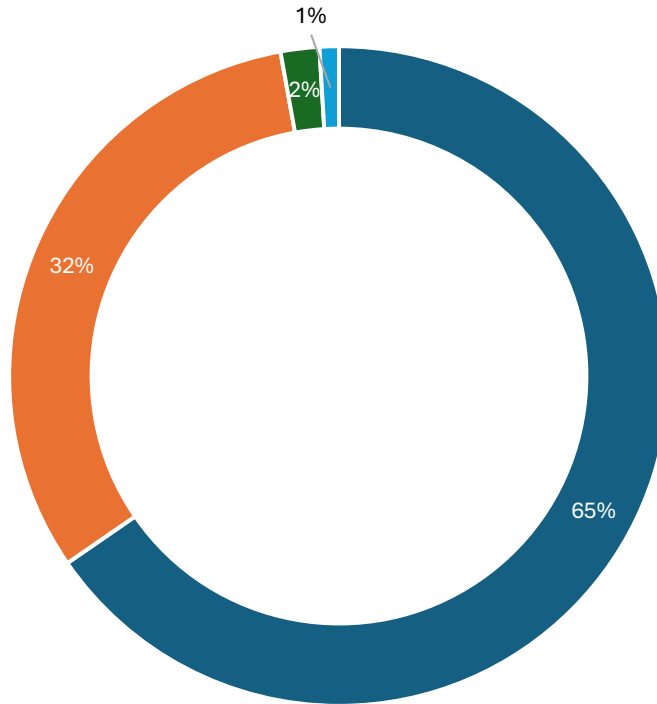

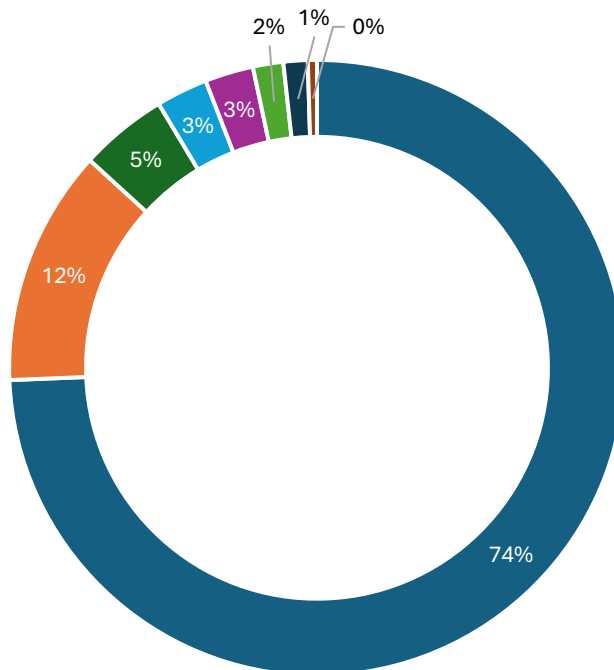

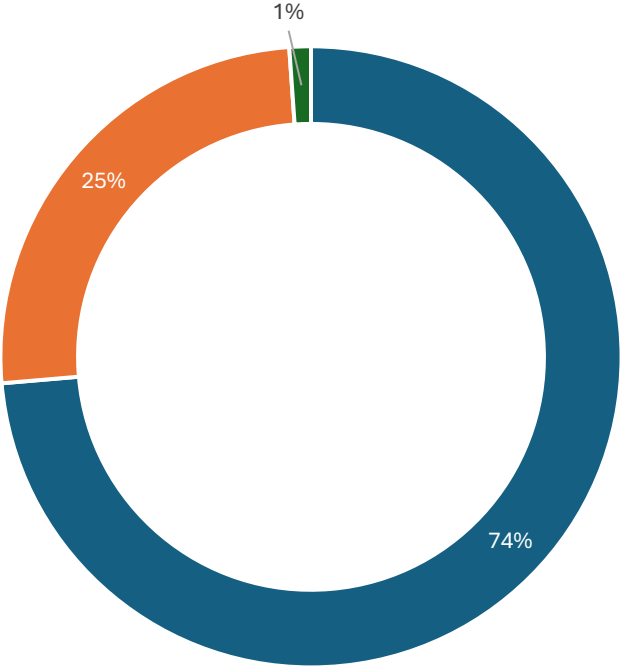

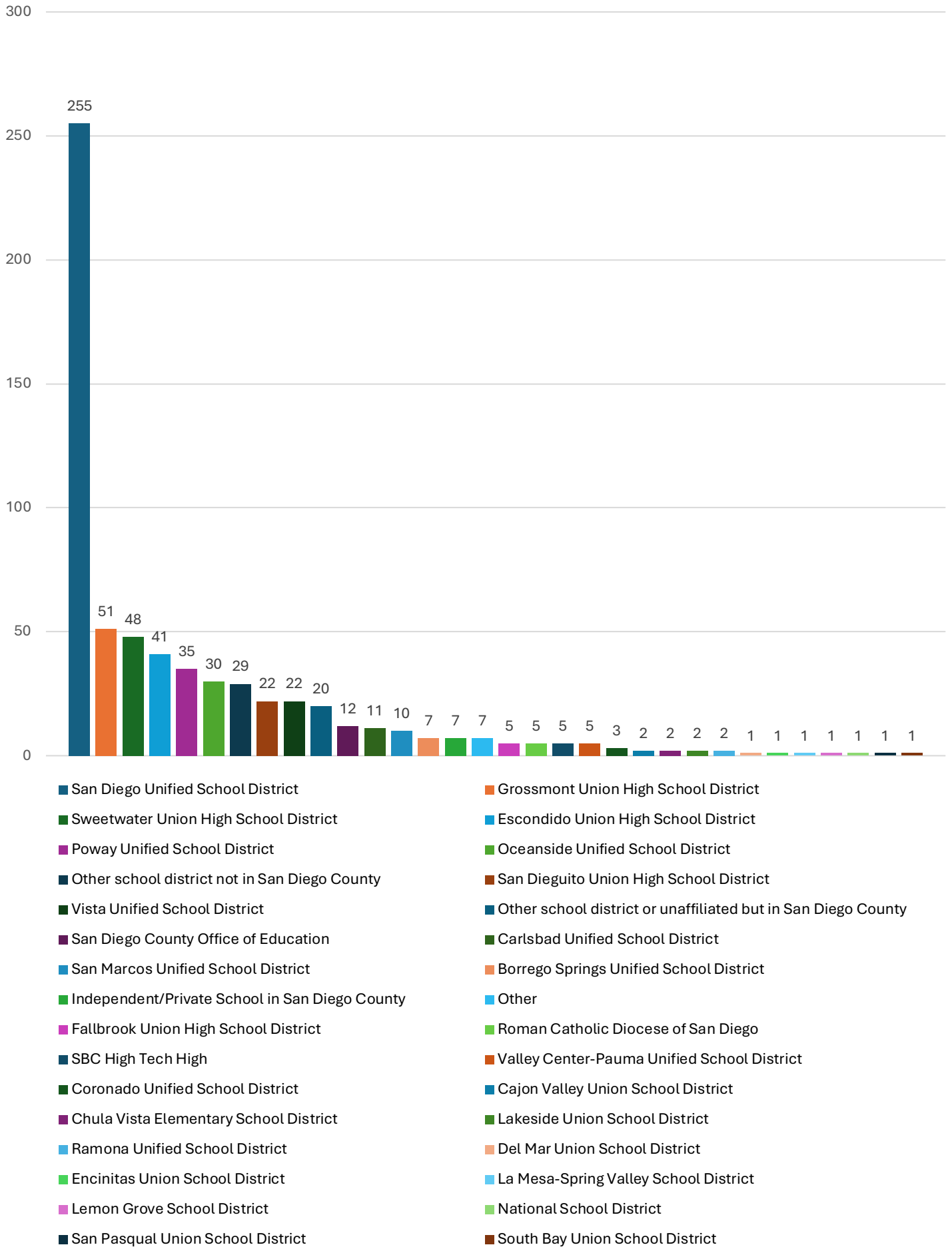

Do you identify as a first generation college student?

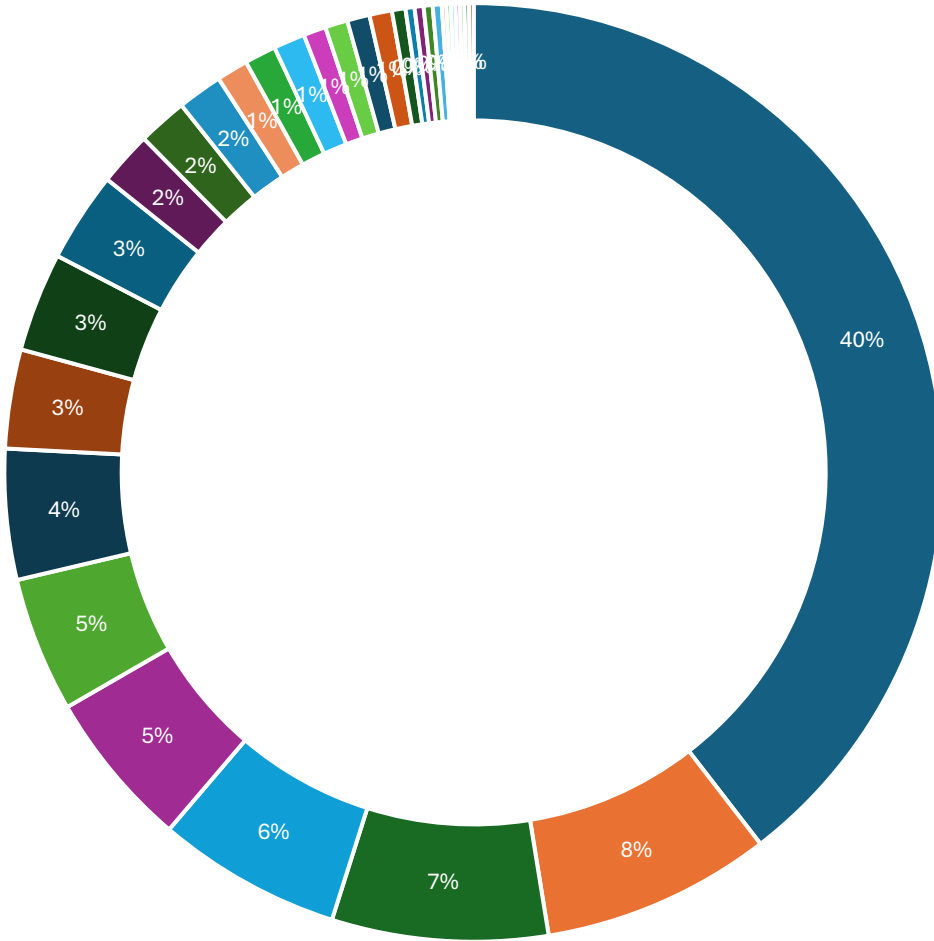

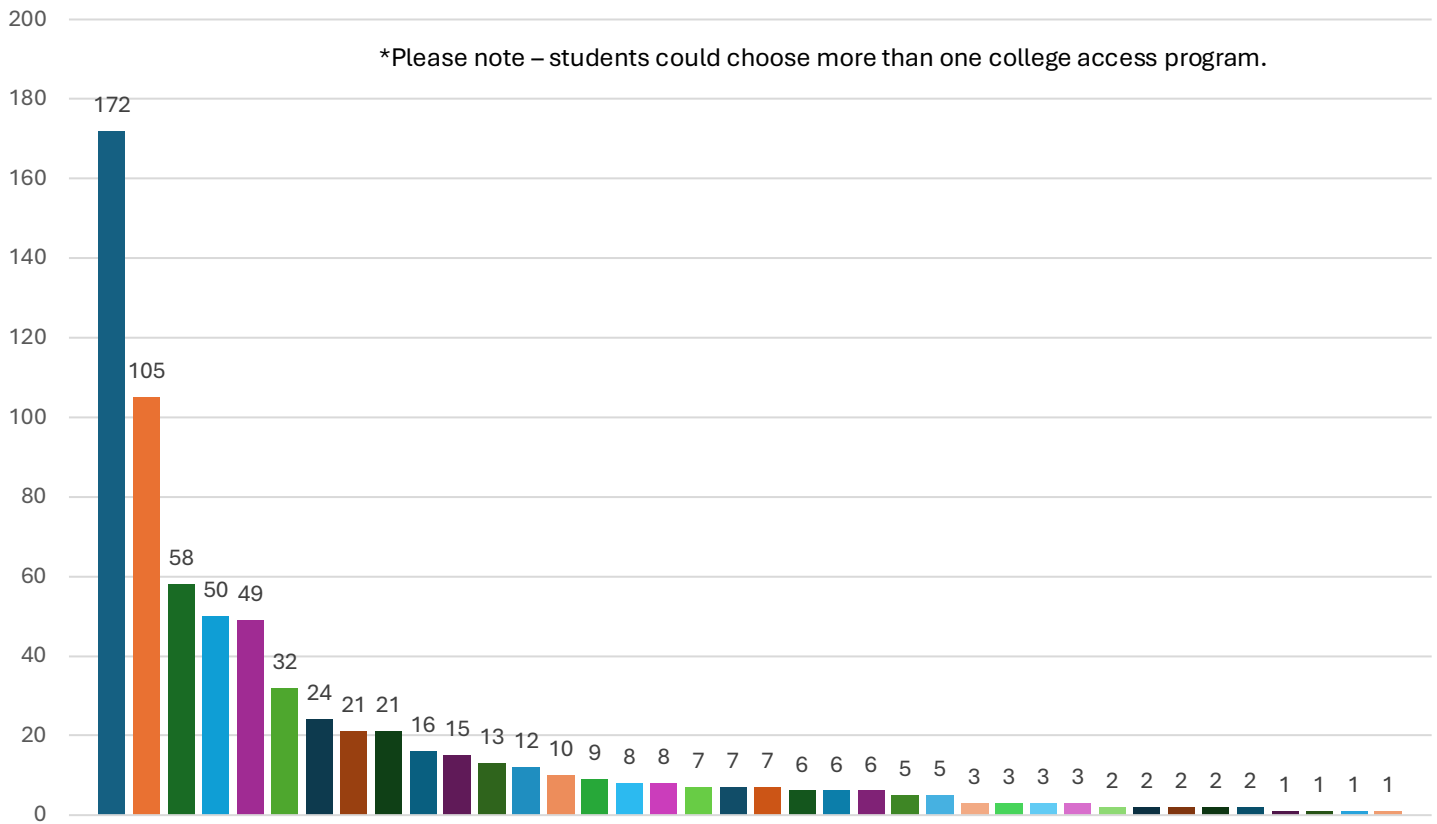

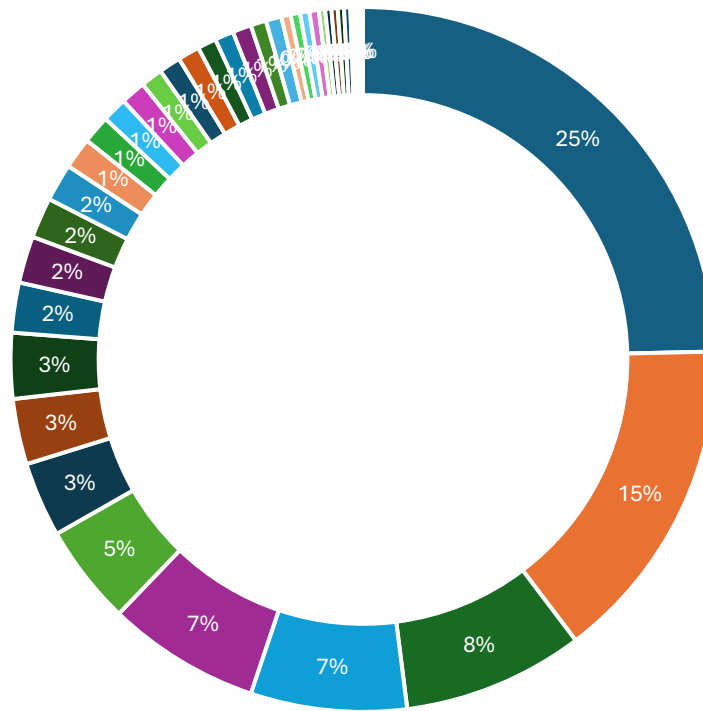
